A PROFILE OF LIFE MEMBERS

1946 - Mr. W. J. Muir *

Windsor was the foundation secretary of the Association and member of St. John's Footscray. He carried the burden of the Association in the pre-war years. Windsor served as Secretary for 4 years, Assistant Secretary 1 year, Vice President 1 year and President 1 year.

1952 - Mr. W. R. Weisheit *

Ray was the President of the Association from 1942 until 1956 a period of 15 years. He also served as a Vice President in 1940 before assuming the Presidency and was a member of St. John's Footscray. He held the position of Australian President in 1955, Auditor of the Australian Association for 25 years, Vice President of the Victorian Association for 5 years and was made a Life Member of that Association in 1954.

1953 - Mr. W. R. Hindson *

Bob was the Secretary of the Association from 1943 until 1952 (10 years), Vice President from 1953 until 1956 (4 years) and President from 1957 until 1959 (3 years). He held the position of Australian Secretary from 1959 until 1968 a period of 10 years, was a Vice-president of the Victorian Association and was made a Life Member of that Association in 1968. He was also Badminton Referee at the last Commonwealth games, and was a Victorian selector. Bob was made a Life Member of the Australian Badminton Association in 1978.

1957 - Mrs. M. J. Boniface *

Marge served on the committee of the Association from 1948 until 1950 (3 years), Vice President from 1951 until 1958 (8 years) and was Secretary from 1959 until 1979 (21 years). She played badminton with the Association from the early days, was a member of the pennant Team and also served the Victorian Association as a Selector. Marge was made a Life Member of the Victorian Association in 1972.

1958 - Miss. D. Melrose *

Dorrie was the Treasurer of the Association from 1941 until 1957 a period of 17 years. Dorrie was a highly efficient treasurer, unobtrusive by nature and was a member of St. Andrew's Williamstown.

1959 - Mr. A. C. Round *

Allan was the Assistant Secretary of the Association in 1951 and 1952 (2 years) and Secretary from 1953 until 1958 a period of 6 years. He was a first class doubles player credited with many wins and was a member of St. Andrew's Williamstown.

1963 - Mr. R. Mayo *

Russell spent some years on the Committee of the Association before succeeding Dorrie Melrose as Treasurer from 1958 until 1968 a period of 11 years.

1964 - Mr. I. D. Scott

Ian spent some years on the Committee of the Association before becoming Vice President in 1950. He assumed the Presidency in 1960 and served until 1965 a period of 6 years, when he was transferred to Papua New Guinea to establish the Technical College System.

1966 - Mr. A. M. Burnham

Max was Vice President of the Association from 1958 until 1965 and President from 1966 to 1972. He was a Vice President of the Victorian Association and was made a Life Member of that Association in 1973. He represented the Association as a member of the Pennant Team and had a reputation as a doubles player.

1969- Mr. R. Gates *

Bob spent some years on the Committee of the Association from 1951 and was Vice President for four years. He was one of the original playing members of the Association, representing St. John's, Footscray.

1976 - Mr. V. Handley

Vic was Vice President of the Association for eighteen years between 1963 and 1980. He was a Foundation Member of the Umpires Association and served as an umpire for many years.

1979 - Mrs. H. J. Bird *

Heather was Treasurer of the Association from 1971 until her untimely death in 1983, a period if thirteen years. She was a player with North Williamstown Presbyterian, West Newport and St. Andrew's, Williamstown.

1985 - Mr. R. C. Croft

Ray has held many positions of the Committee of the Association. He was Hon. Match Secretary from 1973 to 1977, Vice President in 1978 until 1979 and again from 1983 to 1985, and he was Hon. Secretary in 1980 and 1981. He has represented the Association at the Melbourne Badminton Association, the Victorian Badminton Association and at the Western region Sports Assembly. He has been a member and Treasurer of the now Westgate Badminton Club for many years.

1989 - Mr. A. G. Walsh

Alan became Vice President of the Association in 1982 and was the President from 1983 until 1988, during which time he and his Committee negotiated with the Altona City Council and were successful in obtaining the lease of the Altona Badminton Centre exclusively for Badminton. Alan played with West Newport and Westgate for many years and has now retired to the bowling green.

1996 - Mrs P. Fox

Phyllis became Secretary of the Laverton Club in 1974, when Miss K. Tompkins (a Teacher) left the school after forming the Laverton High School Club, which entered the W.S.B.A. Summer Competition in 1971/72.

Phyllis was also Secretary of the Try Youth Club from 1976-1983. She made the Laverton High School Hall available for tournaments, meetings and finals.

Phyllis helped in the organising and training of Western Suburbs under-age teams from 1974-1985, before the Altona Badminton Centre was built.

Phyllis helped to organise Westchamps in the 1980's and provided refreshments for participants. Phyllis retired as the Secretary of Laverton Badminton Club at the end of 2007.

1998 - Mr R. Gray

Ron joined the Committee of W.S.B.A.Inc. in 1983, was Hon.Treasurer from 1985-1989, Vice-President in 1990, Committee Member in 1991 &1992, Hon. Treasurer from 1993-1995 and a Committee Member from 1996-1998.

Ron has played with Keilor East for some years and prior to that with Essendon.

As a Committee Member, Ron continues to oversee the role of Treasurer, which requires dedication and commitment on a weekly basis for the entire year.

Awarding Ron a Life Membership is a small way of thanking him for his dedication to the continued success of W.S.B.A. Inc.

1999 - Mr A. Black

Alan joined the Committee as Vice-President in 1987 and became Senior Vice-President in 1990. Alan took on the role of the Match Secretary during 1990 and continued to hold this position until the end of 2006. During these years, Alan has been one of the Event Directors for the many successful Tournaments run by W.S.B.A. Inc., including the annual Altona Open & Graded Tournament and Under 13/15/17/19 Selection Tournaments.

Alan was the Chairman of our Junior Committee, which organises our Friday Night Junior Competition and Coaching, from 1989 until 2006.

Alan was a member of and a Selector for the Victorian Junior Badminton Association, a sub-committee of Badminton Victoria for many years and the Event Director for many of their tournaments.

2000 - Mrs P.M. Daw

Pat joined the committee, chairing her first meeting as President in 1989 and still holds this position. Pat took over the day to day running of the Altona Badminton Centre and spent many hours organising the staff and overseeing the administration of the Stadium.

Pat has been involved in the organisation of many W.S.B.A.Inc. tournaments at our stadium and has been the Event Director for an Under 19 Australian Carnival and Under 17 Australasian Badminton Carnival hosted by Badminton Victoria.

Pat was a member of Victorian Badminton Association Council in the 1960's, a member of the Badminton Victoria Review Committee in 1999 and has worked, as a volunteer, at Badminton Australia collating tournament results.

Pat became interested in badminton when she went to pennant competition matches at St Johns Footscray with her parents Ray & Mavis Weisheit and played for about forty years. This is the first time a child of one of our Life Members has also become a Life member, Pat's father, Ray, was awarded a Life Membership in 1952.

2001 - Mrs N. J. Cronin

Natalie began playing badminton in about 1934 and continued playing until about 1989. Nat played in Bendigo & Echuca before coming to Williamstown in 1973 where she joined St Andrew's daytime ladies and then the St Stephen's night competition team which she helped to organise.

In 1985, Nat joined the "Committee for Catering at Official Functions", the highlights of which were the Silver Bowl and the Australian Championships. In the Annual Report for that year, Nat was thanked for her "Special Event" catering and her "attention to detail" in the organisation of the hospitality provide for players, sponsors, officials, guests and volunteers. During the early years of the Altona Badminton Centre, Nat and Jerry were involve in the organisation of Friday Night Juniors and worked as volunteers in the Pro Shop, selling in the Kiosk and taking court bookings.

Nat joined the W.S.B.A.Inc. Committee in 1984, prior to the opening of the Stadium and served as a Committee Member until 1988. Nat took on the role of Honorary Secretary in 1989 and 1990, was Vice-President from 1991-1993 and Senior Vice-President to now. Nat is also the Public Officer of the Association.

2002 - Mrs H. Black

Hilary began playing badminton at St Luke's, Yarraville in 1958. Hilary played until the end of the Autumn Season 1999. Hilary served on the Keilor East Committee in 1973 , 1977 – 81, 1983, 1984 – 1986. In 1987 Hilary became Secretary and Public Officer and is now in her $16^{\rm th}$ year of holding these offices.

Hilary, along with Alan, became involved with the Juniors when the Altona Badminton Centre opened in 1985. A Junior Sub-Committee was formed in 1986, Alan became Chairman in 1989 and Hilary has been organizing Friday night Juniors since then.

Hilary has been a W.S.B.A.Inc. Delegate to Badminton Victoria for a number of years. Hilary has been the scorer at our Junior & Open Tournaments for many years and also assists with catering for these events.

2006 - Mrs M. Ravenhall

Marj has been a member and player of the Keilor East Badminton Association Inc. since 1969, when it was formed. Marj joined the Keilor East Committee in 1974. Marj became President in 1989.

Marj, supported the plan for Keilor East to become Incorporated in the mid 1980s. Her input to the Keilor East Committee results in strong and consistent support to WSBA. Marj has been one of the Keilor East delegates for the WSBA Annual Meetings for many years.

Marj played pennant competition in many different venues until 2004.

Marj was on the Canteen Committee when the Altona Badminton Centre first opened and was presented with a Service Award in 1997.

In January we again hosted the Under 13 Interstate Series and at the end of September the 2008 Under 15 Australasian Badminton Carnival, incorporating the Val Nesbitt Trophy and the Regional Teams Challenge. WSBA entered three

teams in the Regional Challenge and we were thrilled to see the Western Suburbs Buccaneers win! Congratulations to Shaun Matthews who won the Regional Teams' Sportsmanship Award.

MANAGER'S REPORT

January began with Altona hosting the second Under 13 Interstate Series. This year we had ten teams enter the competition – up from six last year. The event was split into an interstate series between two teams from New South Wales, two teams from Victoria and a regional series comprising of two Western Suburbs teams and teams from Australian Capital Territory, Tasmania, Western Victoria and Badminton Academy of Victoria.

Our Autumn pennant season commenced in February with 58 teams (down 3 from the previous season).

February 23rd & 24th saw us run the Altona Open and Graded tournament.

Over April 12th & 13th we hosted the Under 19, Under 15 and Under 11 Altona Junior Open. This event was a selection tournament for the Under 19's and the Under 15's, so was well attended.

Thanks to the people who assisted with all these events.

Our Spring pennant season commenced in July and the number of teams increased by 1, to a total of 59 teams. Unfortunately A grade fell by two teams to only four teams playing out the season. Hopefully next season will see in increase in the number of teams in this grade.

Our presentation to the Hobsons Bay City Council did not gain their approval for the 2008/2009 budget. We have been keeping close contact with the Mayor and our local councillor to get a more favourable result in the next budget. Unfortunately the Mayor is not standing for re-election and our long serving ward councillor is facing a tough election very shortly. We will reintroduce ourselves to the new council when it is elected.

We have also had great contact with local member Wade Noonan, who has met with us on several occasions and is keen to lend his support.

The centre is fortunate to have a reliable and co-operative group of employees making up our staff. During the year we appointed new stadium cleaners who have given a professional touch to the cleaning contract. Don commenced his 23rd year of service with us looking after the foyer and toilet areas. Susan, Erin, Ann, Norma and Alexandra have provided great support along with Richard who looks after the security of the car park.

The end of the financial year saw us preparing for the 2008 Under 15 carnival incorporating the Val Nesbitt Trophy and the Regional Teams' Event

Western Suburbs Badminton Association Junior Development Program 2008

The Western Suburbs Badminton Association Development Program continues to develop a structured pathway in badminton for children in the Western Suburbs. This program offers school clinics & programs, junior competition, beginner coaching sessions, Junior Development squads & Combined Regional Academy training. To feed our development we focus on the first three areas where children who are identified as showing talent for the sport are selected and then invited to join the Junior Development Squad or applicable coaching session. The aim of this structure is to provide developmental opportunity and encouragement for talented young sports persons to assist them in reaching their full potential in badminton. As the program has now been in place for some six years we are seeing results with children who have been talent-identified in school programs now making Victorian teams and squads.

School Participation Program

The program this year delivered school clinics and Active After School Care Programs to the schools in the western suburbs on request. Regular contact with the Primary & Secondary Schools continued offering program information and clinic request forms and where possible we advertise in their school newsletters.

This year 800 children participated in the program; 100 more than the participation for 2007. They were from the following schools:

Development Squads & Casual Coaching Sessions

W.S.B.A. continued to deliver 3 Squad Sessions per week for 55 members, almost half of these members attended 2 sessions per week this year. In addition to weekly squad training, WSBA together with Ballarat, Bendigo & Gippsland Academies conducted combined training sessions. Four sessions were held in the various regions, each Academy selected 12 players to attend these sessions that were well received and enjoyed by the players.

The Casual Beginner Coaching Sessions for all age groups continued on Fridays & Sundays. These sessions, while well attended showed a drop in numbers from 2007. On a Friday nights, numbers dropped to around 20 from a previous 35 and Sunday Casual Session average dropped to 15 from a previous 25. Apart from the current economic situation, one of the contributing factors to the drop in numbers in this area is that in 2007 WSBA had several referrals

from girls who were unsuccessful in selection of the Badminton Australia Jump Smash Program. Unfortunately these girls were not from the western suburbs and the traveling from other areas in Melbourne was an issue, hence almost all stopped attending after the free period finished.

Coaching Clinics during the school holidays this year have been well attended.
