## **Conditions of Entry**

All players submitting entries for this tournament will be deemed to have read, understood and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted. Competitors play at their own risk.

### Rules & Regulations

 Regulations: The tournament will be conducted initially in accordance with the BV Generic Polices, Sport Injury and Risk Management Standards as adopted by Badminton Victoria, followed by the Laws of Badminton, General Competition Regulations & Player Code of Conduct as adopted by the Badminton World Federation (BWF), except where modified by these conditions.

#### 2. BWF Alternate Service rule will be used for this tournament

9.1.6 a) the whole shuttle shall be below the server's waist at the instant of being hit by the server's racket. The waist shall be considered to be an imaginary line round the body, level with the lowest part of the server's bottom rib; b) the shaft and the racket head of the server's racket at the instant of hitting the shuttle shall be pointing in a downward direction.

- 3. Please Note BWF Rule actioned the 27<sup>th</sup> May 2015: "If a player withdraws, after the draw has been made, or retires injured/ill during a match, they will then be withdrawn from all other events entered in the tournament."
- 4. The Referee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament and will adjudicate on all matters relating to these conditions, adopted Badminton Victoria policy and adopted **BWF Laws, Regulations & Codes of Conduct**.
- 5. The Tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entry and may cancel an event if insufficient entries are received. **Players are restricted to one age group per day**.
- 6. Eligibility: Players must be underage as of the 31st December 2021
- 7. Players who enter doubles as '**partner required**' must update their online entry prior to the closing date of entries if they have arranged a partner for the event. When the tournament entries close the tournament organiser will assign any available players to those who are without partners. The decision of the tournament organiser will be final.
- 8. **BV Affiliation:** All players are required to be a current fully paid member listed on a Member Database of Badminton Victoria Affiliated Association or another State Body affiliated with Badminton Australia. Any player who is not a current full paid member of BV as on the entry closing date will be ineligible to play at this tournament. - Player ID: Players should first use their BWF number should they have one, followed by their Badminton Australia Player ID. Players should not use association ID numbers. Player IDs can be found at <u>badminton.org.au</u> > High Performance > Player ID. Please Note: Holding a Player ID does not necessarily mean you are a full financial member of Badminton Victoria.
- 10. Entrants consent to the collection of their details and image by tournament organisers and understand that such information may be passed onto and used by Badminton Victoria Inc. Entrants acknowledge their right to access and correct such information.
- 11. **Entries close** Please refer to the information provided in the summary at the beginning. No late entries will be accepted. Entries must be submitted online only. Email, mail, fax or phone entries will not be accepted.
- 12. Entry Lists and Order of Play will be published after the close of entries with a link via <u>badmintonvic.com.au</u> to Tournament Software. It is the responsibility of the entrant to check their entry and report any errors to the tournament organisers before the withdrawal date.
- 13. **Seeding** will be done based on the Badminton Australia National Ranking System with points as of the date specified in the summary at the beginning.
- 14. Play will commence as stated on the coversheet, unless otherwise notified.
- 15. Enquiries regarding starting times of matches are the responsibility of entrants. The timetable for the event will also be placed on the tournament website and in the venue. The Referee has the power to disqualify any player not available to play when called to do so. Any alterations made to the competition schedule due to unforeseen circumstances will be announced by the Referee. The schedule may alter depending on the number of entries received.
- 16. Players will be required to umpire matches when called to do so.

### 17. Scoring and Structure:

- 18. All players must wear racquet sport attire that conforms to the BWF Competition Regulations (Clothing). Tracksuits will only be permitted for warm up. Non-marking shoes must be worn.
- 19. The shuttle brand in use will be determined by the host.
- 20. <u>COVID-19 Requirements</u> As per the State Government COVID-19 Roadmap announcement, all players, parents, guardians, officials, coaches, event staff and spectators will need to meet the COVID-19 vaccination requirements that are in place at the time of the tournament. Currently, everyone aged 16 years and over, will need to be able to provide proof of being fully vaccinated (unless proof of exemption can be provided). - 21. Depending on the relevant date and the cap on patrons, spectators and other non-players may be unable to be in attendance during the event. Entries may need to be limited to ensure we do not exceed mandated caps.
