All players are to pay entry fees - Payment must be made with entry.

**BV Affiliation:** All players are required to be a current member of a Badminton Victoria.

**Withdrawals:** A full refund can be provided to individuals who withdraw from the tournament or an event up to 10 days before the commencement of the tournament. Individuals withdrawing from the tournament or an event after this date will not be provided with a refund on any fees paid.



# Conditions of Entry

All players submitting entries for this tournament will be deemed to have read, understood and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted. Competitors play at their own risk.

## Rules & Regulations

1. Regulations: The tournament will be conducted initially in accordance with the BV Generic Polices, Sport Injury and Risk Management Standards as adopted by Badminton Victoria, followed by the Laws of Badminton, General Competition Regulations & Player Code of Conduct as adopted by the Badminton World Federation (BWF), except where modified by these conditions.
2. Please Note BWF Rule actioned the 27th May 2015: "If a player withdraws, after the draw has been made, or retires injured/ill during a match, they will then be withdrawn from all other events entered in the tournament."
3. The Referee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament and will adjudicate on all matters relating to these conditions, adopted Badminton Victoria policy and adopted BWF Laws, Regulations & Codes of Conduct.
4. The Tournament committee reserves the right to reject any entry and may cancel an event if insufficient entries are received. Players are restricted to one age group per day.
5. Eligibility: Players must be under age as of the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017.
6. Players who enter doubles as 'partner required' must update their online entry prior to the closing date of entries if they have arranged a partner for the event. When the tournament entries close the tournament organiser will assign any available players to those who are without partners. The decision of the tournament organiser will be final.
7. BV Affiliation: All players are required to be a current fully paid member listed on a Member Database of Badminton Victoria Affiliated Association or another State Body affiliated with Badminton Australia. Any player who is not a current full paid member of BV as on the entry closing date will be ineligible to play at this tournament. 8. Player ID Numbers: Players should first use their BWF number should they have one, followed by their Victorian or State ID number. Players should not use association ID numbers. BWF & State ID numbers can be found at [badminton.org.au](http://badminton.org.au) > High Performance > Player ID. Please Note: Holding a Player ID Number does not necessarily mean you are a full financial member of Badminton Victoria.
9. Entrants consent to the collection of their details and image by tournament organisers and understand that such information may be passed onto and used by Badminton Victoria Inc. Entrants acknowledge their right to access and correct such information.
10. Bulk entries will close on the 28<sup>th</sup> October 2017. No late bulk entries will be accepted. Bulk entries are only for authorized officers of an affiliated BV Association who are entering 5 or more players into a tournament. Bulk entries will only be accepted if they are completed on an official BV bulk entry template available from the [badmintonvic.com.au](http://badmintonvic.com.au) > Tournaments > Tournament Resources > BV Bulk Entry Form Template. Bulk entry forms must have every field completed correctly (including the correct Player ID Numbers) to be accepted.
11. Entries close on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2017. No late entries will be accepted. Entries must be submitted online only. Email, mail, fax or phone entries will not be accepted.
12. Entry Lists and Order of Play will be published after the close of entries with a link via [badmintonvic.com.au](http://badmintonvic.com.au) to Tournament Software. It is the responsibility of the entrant to check their entry and report any errors to the tournament organisers before the withdrawal date.
13. Seeding will be done based on the Badminton Australia National Ranking System with points as of the 1<sup>st</sup> November 2017.
14. Play will commence at 1:00pm on Saturday and 8:30am on Sunday, unless otherwise notified.
15. Enquiries regarding starting times of matches are the responsibility of entrants. The timetable for the event will also be placed on the tournament website and in the venue. The Referee has the power to disqualify any player not available to play when called to do so. Any alterations made to the competition schedule due to unforeseen circumstances will be announced by the Referee. The schedule may alter depending on the number of entries received.
16. Players will be required to umpire matches when called to do so.
17. U13 events will be 1 game to 30 no setting, all other events will be best of 3 games to 21 points, with setting to 30 points. Rally point scoring will be used for all events. All events will be round robin qualifying with an elimination main draw, where possible.
18. All players must wear racquet sport attire that conforms to the BWF Competition Regulations (Clothing). Tracksuits will only be permitted for warm up. Non-marking shoes must be worn.
19. The shuttle brand in use will be published at the time of the draw
